# Second Transnational Training Workshop (16<sup>th</sup> -19<sup>th</sup> January 2023) Hosted Institute: Georg August University, Gottingen, Germany

The Transnational Training program of the Capacity Building in Higher Education project on "Enhancing Governance, Management and Reforms in Sri Lankan Universities through Non-Academic Staff Training (ENACT) on Modern Practices in HRM, University Administration and Financial Management was held from 16th -19th January, 2023 at the Georg August University, Gottingen, Germany.

All European partners of this project participated in the program which was hosted by the Georg August University, Gottingen, Germany. This program included 33 members from Sri Lankan partner Universities and 4 members from the European partner organizations.

#### Scope of Training & Trainers

The primary focus of the training was to familiarize our Sri Lankan partners with the policies, strategies, and norms practiced by the EU in various areas. These areas include recruitment and talent management, performance management, legal and regulatory frameworks, organizational development and governance, financial management, infrastructure and service management, and sustainability. Additionally, the training highlighted how digitalization can improve efficiency in these domains. Trainers from the EU region, including Netra Bhandari (UGOE), Rui Mendes (IST), Ana Lucas (IST), Uwe Muuss (UGOE), Nuno Pedroso (IST), Manco Lange (UGOE), and Gergana (ECQ), shared their expertise and insights on these subjects.

The team from SLTC successfully completed the training program, which aimed at enhancing governance, management, and reform in Sri Lankan universities through the development of administrative staff. Trainees from all six partner universities successfully completed the training program.

Project Management Meeting and Workshop on Joint Development and Improvement of the Non-Academic Staff Training and Development Strategy at each Sri Lanka University

The Project Management meeting combined with a Workshop on Joint Development and Improvement of the Non-academic Staff Training and Development Strategy at each Sri Lanka University was held from 11- 13 July 2023 at SLTC, Padukka. This meeting and workshop were organized by the University of Moratuwa and hosted by the SLTC.

This Project Management meeting was a working meeting of the Project Management Committee which involved transnational mobility. It was focused on the following aspects:

- Review technical and financial implementation and reporting including quality of outputs and results
- Streamlining project management and implementation
- Planning of remaining tasks related to WP3 with particular attention to the development of Non-Academic Staff Development Cells
- Joint development and improvement of Mandate Documents and Action Plans for these Cells
- Joint development and improvement of the Non-Academic Staff Training and Development Strategy at each Sri Lanka University.

The Coordinator, ENACT presented the overall progress of the project in the meeting. The Work Package leaders presented the progress and implementation of each work package. Dr. <u>Gergana Cisarova-Dimitrova</u> from ECQ, Bulgaria presented the Quality report of the implemented activities and future recommendations. In addition to this, the financial management, and dissemination activities were also reviewed. The Sri Lankan partner universities presented their draft Non-academic Staff Development Strategies and the EU partners provided their inputs to improve the strategies.

Mr. Rui Mendis from Instituto Superior Tecnico, Lisbon, Portugal conducted the workshop on Joint Development and Improvement of the Non-academic Staff Training and Development Strategy at Sri Lanka University.

20 members from Sri Lankan Partner Universities and 08 members from European Partners participated in the event.

The Transnational Training program of the Capacity Building in Higher Education project on "Enhancing Governance, Management and Reforms in Sri Lankan Universities through Non-Academic Staff Training (ENACT) on the title of Soft skills, Diversity and Equality was held from 13 – 16 November 2023 at the Instituto Superior Tecnico, Lisbon, Portugal.

All European Partners of the project participated in this program which was hosted by the Instituto Superior Tecnico, Lisbon, Portugal. This included 30 members from Sri Lankan partner Universities and 11 members from the European Parner Organizations.
